4. District LCAP Survey (15 minutes)	Council	Informational	Principal shared LCAP Goals and Budget and invited suggestions from team for other resources needed. Our shared feedback: What we want to ask the district to pay for: We are asking the district to pay for an additional VP even if enrollment is under 1,000 students from goal area 3,4. No support teachers on campus (ELSTs). Request ELD resource teacher on site. Remind the district to provide more services on site for our EL populations. This can come from goal area 1, 3.
			Adding school police for middle schools. (currently only HS get resource officers)

5. Fiscal Report 2019 Year (15 minutes)	Council	Vote	Hendricks: Motion to move this agenda item ahead of agenda item #4. Motion approved unanimously. LCFF (09800) LCFF fiscal report shows us a -\$4,768.37. (We are paying for last years counselors for the month of July, this is due to our year round schedule because fiscal year starts in July. We are going to ask the district for financial help since Clark is at a disadvantage due to year round schedule. We can't spend anymore out of this area but we will be asking the district for help funding July counselor expense. Title 1 (30100) Title I we are negative for classroom teacher because the teacher in the position exceeded the average salary. We have a surplus of \$11,000 for Prof Dev and District provided about \$40,000 Professional Development so we could reallocate this money. Hendricks: Propose we move the entire amount (line 1192) to the classroom teacher (line 1107): \$11,143.88. We are still short by \$146.45 Ms. Hendricks: Motion to approve, Mr. Lea seconded. 7 for, 1 against - Motion carries

Motion approved unanimously Ms. Hernandez: Motion to move \$12,589.28 from line 4301 (supplies) to cover all remaining negative balances in resource 30100. Ms. Hendricks seconded Motion approved unanimously. Title 1 Parent Involvement (30103) We are -\$2,889.66 in Inservice supplies. This includes food for Coffee with the Principal, other parent meetings. Ms. Hernandez. Motion to leave \$200 in supplies (4301) and move all remaining money (4283.98) from 4301(Supplies) to line 4304 (Inservice supplies). Ms. Chilapa seconded.
